Keeping ON TOP Of The Latest!

Dr. Kuhn, Dr. Grimshaw and team stay busy learning

Dr. Kuhn and seven team members completed advanced training in "Comprehensive Aesthetic Reconstruction" at the renowned LVI Institute For Advanced Dental Studies. The course focused on advanced methods that combine accurate bite alignment with an attractive smile balanced to the unique facial structure of each patient.

As part of the curriculum, Dr. Kuhn brought an actual patient for treatment. In this, Dr. Kuhn placed all porcelain, full upper arch crowns and veneers to repair severely worn teeth as a result of night-time grinding and to cover deep tetracycline staining, giving the patient a radiant smile in the process.



"By ensuring proper bite alignment and esthetic outcome are combined in treatment, the patient enjoys a smile that looks great and works in harmony with muscles, joints, and other teeth," he states.

As a graduate of the LVI Institute, Dr. Kuhn has achieved advanced dental skills very few dentists ever attain.

Dr. Mandy Kuhn Grimshaw completed advanced training in the utilization of CEREC 3D in a two-day course held in Atlanta. During this, she furthered her skills in the preparation and restoration techniques of CEREC 3 to create in-office dental restorations.

CEREC uses a 3-D infrared camera to calculate precision dimensions for the prepared tooth. With computerized technology, porcelain restorations are created to provide patients accurate ceramic restorations in one visit.

Dr. Grimshaw also completed a two-day course on root canal treatment. "Endodontic Excellence" was held at the Georgia headquarters of Practical Endodontics. This session expanded her skills in endodontic therapy.

The curriculum focused on diagnosis and methods to provide patients with increased comfort while reducing time in treatment.

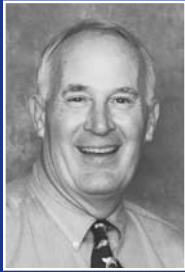
